paper

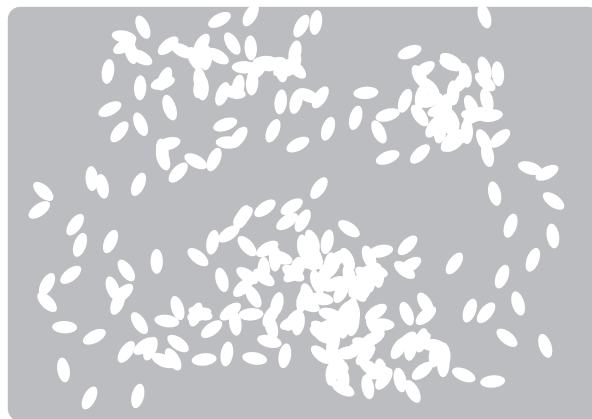


pen/pencil

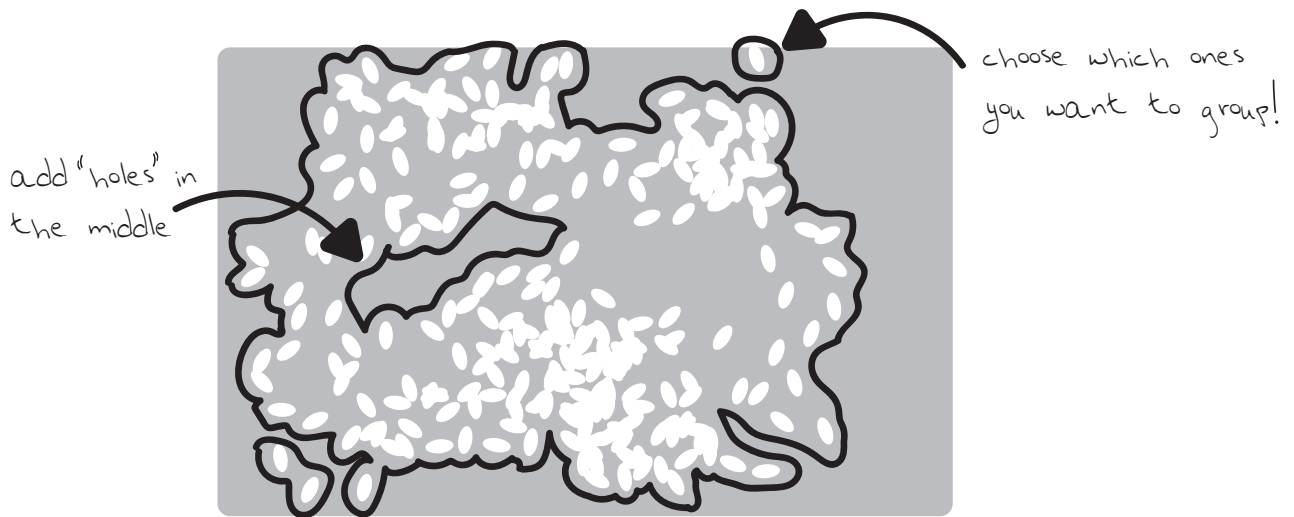


rice/beans/beads/
cereal/etc

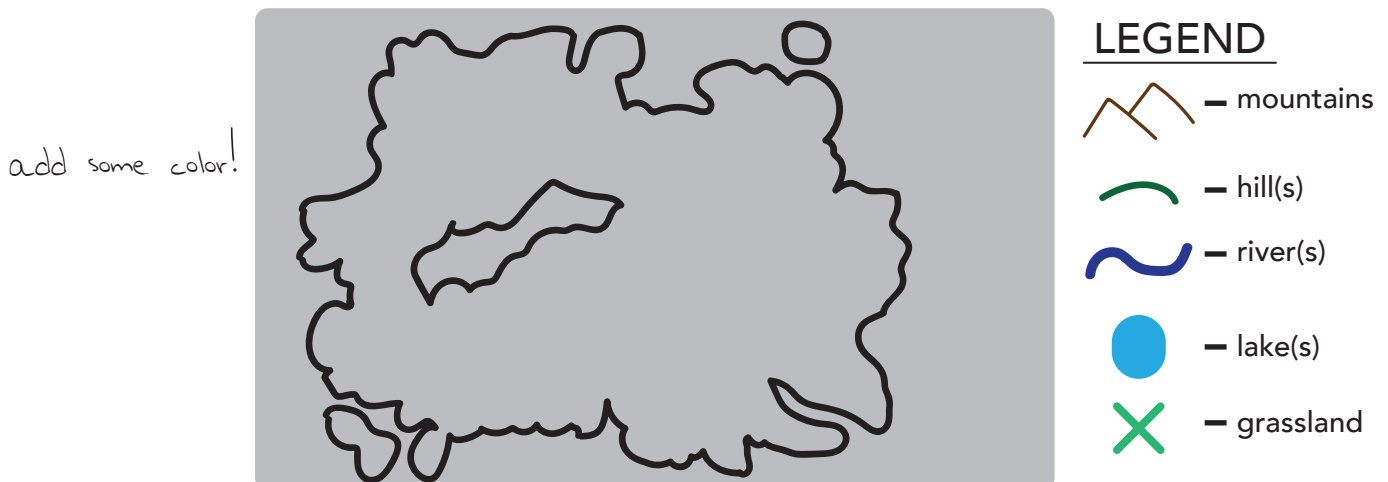
STEP 1: Spill the beans! Or rice. Take your piece of paper and place rice on your paper. It should be as random as you can but make sure you have clumps of rice. Use a decent amount too!



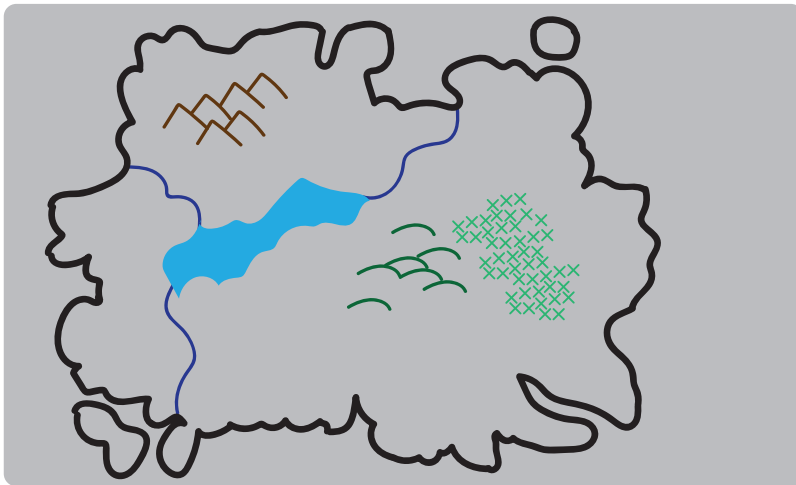
STEP 2: Time to trace! Using your pen/pencil and being careful not to move your rice (or other chosen material), trace around the different groupings of material. Be as creative and crazy as you want!








STEP 3: Now you have your own little continent! We're going to take it one step further now and make our own map of our new-found continent. We'll start by making some symbols to represent different things such as mountains, rivers, lakes, towns, etc. This will be on the side in what's called a Legend.



STEP 3: Let's make a map! Start adding your symbols anywhere you want on your map. If you really want it to be random, assign a number to each element on your legend and roll it on your map. Wherever it lands, and whatever number it lands on, is where you put that element! Congrats, you've made a map!
